Managing Information Assets. Personnel from the government sector like Department of National Defense, National Bureau of Investigation, including Philippine Accreditation Office (PAO), among others; and personnel from the banking sector undergo a training on information security as an integral component in a management system of an organisation. This feature is outlined in ISO/IEC 27001 and interrelated with ISO/IEC 27006 as composite training module to provide participants a greater understanding of the formal requirements of getting an ISO 27001 certification; while on the other hand, it also provide the participants involve in auditing or certifying identify the requirements and regime of auditing organisations seeking accreditation under ISO 27001.
